DOG POLICY FOR GLC PROPERTY

Dogs shall be allowed on all GLC property subject to the following conditions:

No dog may jump at or upon, or otherwise threaten persons or other animals using streets, walkways, parks or other public ways

Owners are responsible for immediately cleaning up after their dogs on all GLC property.

Except in exempt areas, the owner or keeper of any dog shall not allow it to be at large and not under control. "Under control" means that the owner, by means of a leash, restrains the dog to the owner's immediate proximity, preventing the dog from trespassing upon property or annoying or chasing other persons, animals, or vehicles of any sort.

Off leash time on GLC property are between the hours 5am-9am
